

## **Australian Capital Territory Highlights**



"...if you are caring for a family member there is an expectation that you will keep on doing so despite not being treated kindly by that person, and yet at the same time you are excluded from any decision making processes."




Whether carers were asked about their own needs


Whether carers felt their views influenced services






"I just want people to appreciate that I do something that is hard, that is extra to what others do, that impacts on so many areas of my life and that I didn't have a choice but to do it."
