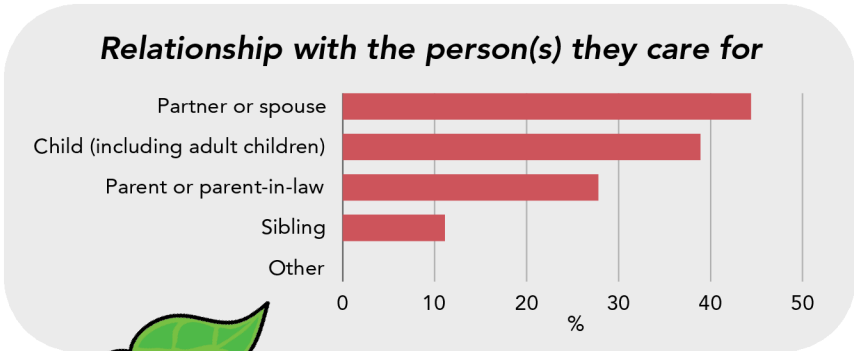
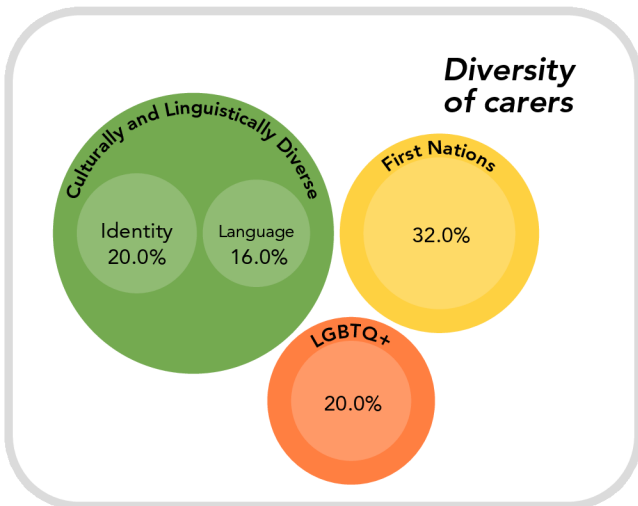
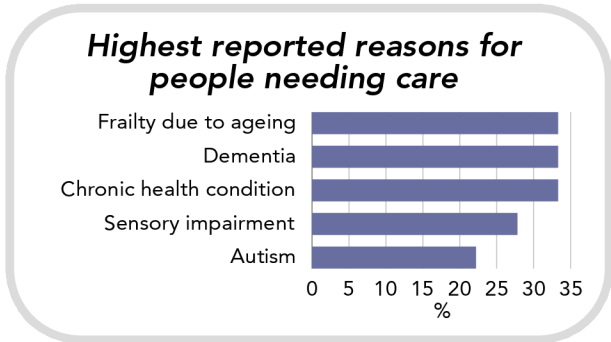
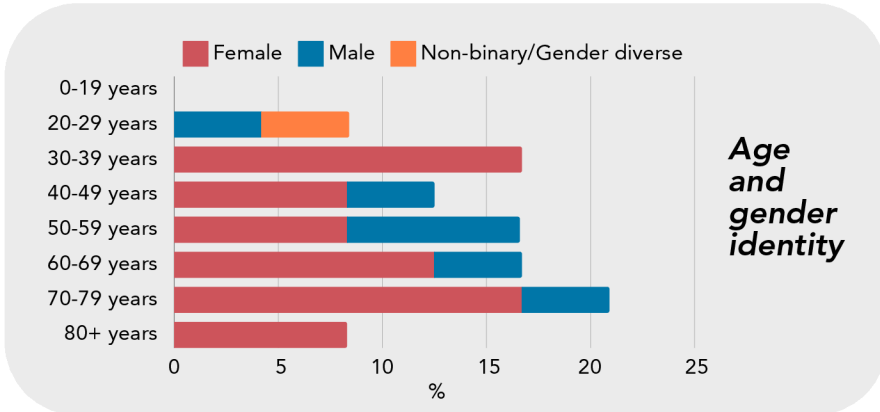


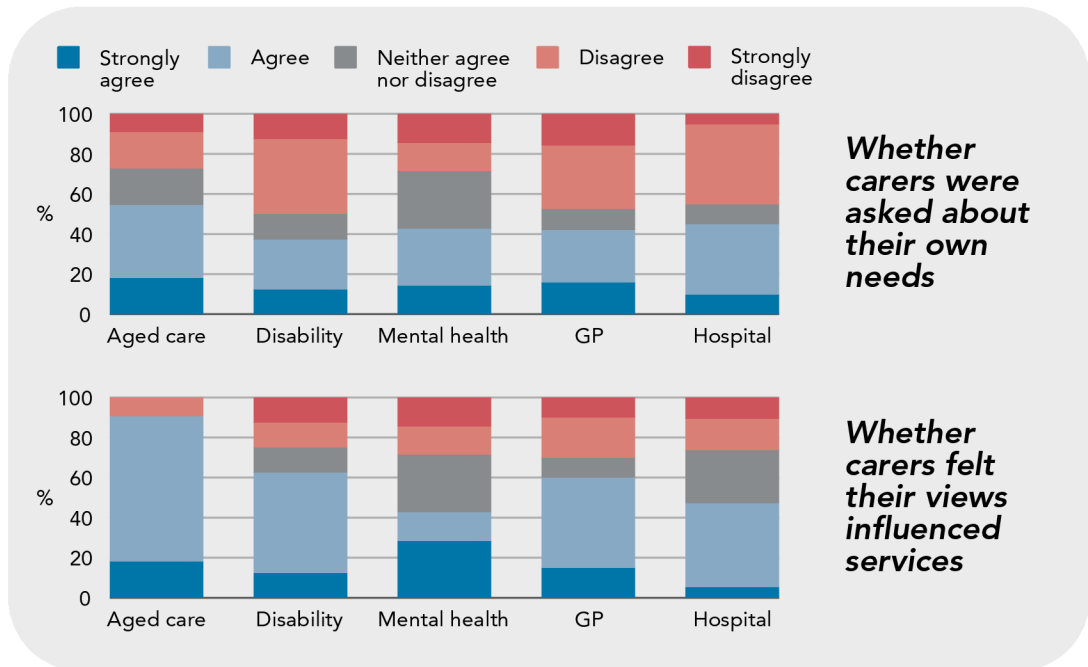


Northern Territory Highlights

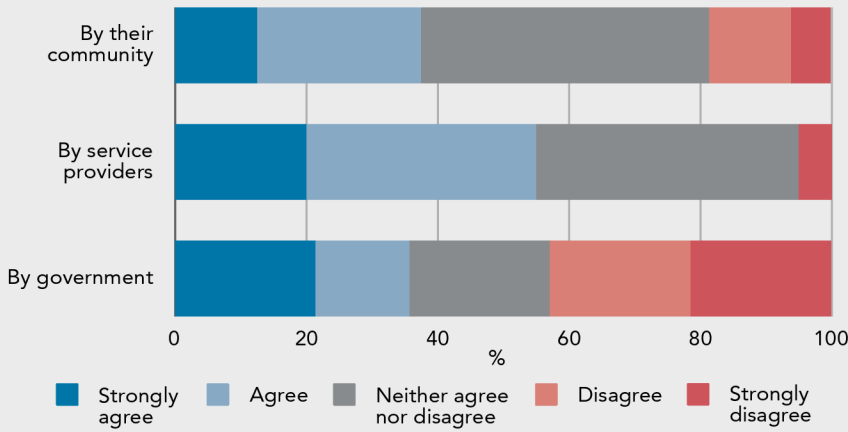

"Support for carers is not coherent with the needs of the cared for and the carer especially when they are actually a domestic unit."

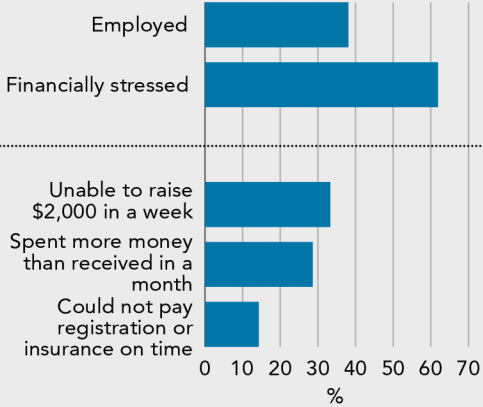

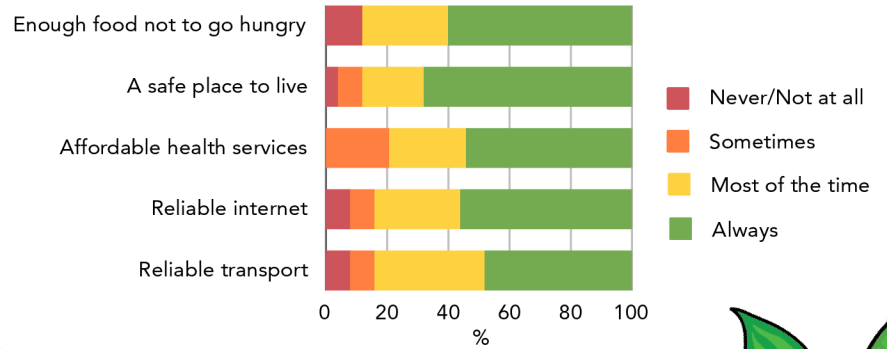


"I have resigned from my job as I need to support my son more."

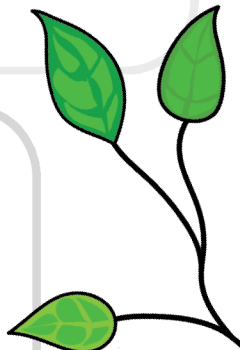
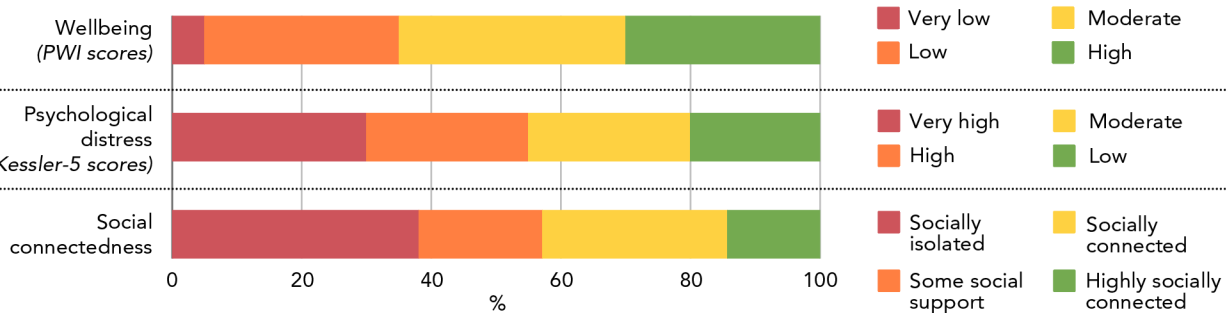
