





Victoria Highlights






Average duration of caring role

"Perhaps simply to be asked about my needs and if I am ok. I am fortunate to be reminded regularly by my husband how much he values what I do for him."




Whether carers were asked about their own needs


Whether carers felt their views influenced services






"Paying for my mother's care has placed financial strain on me and security for the future."
